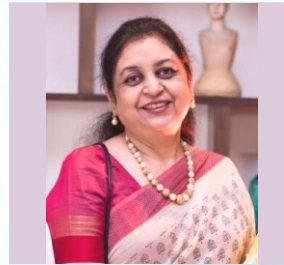

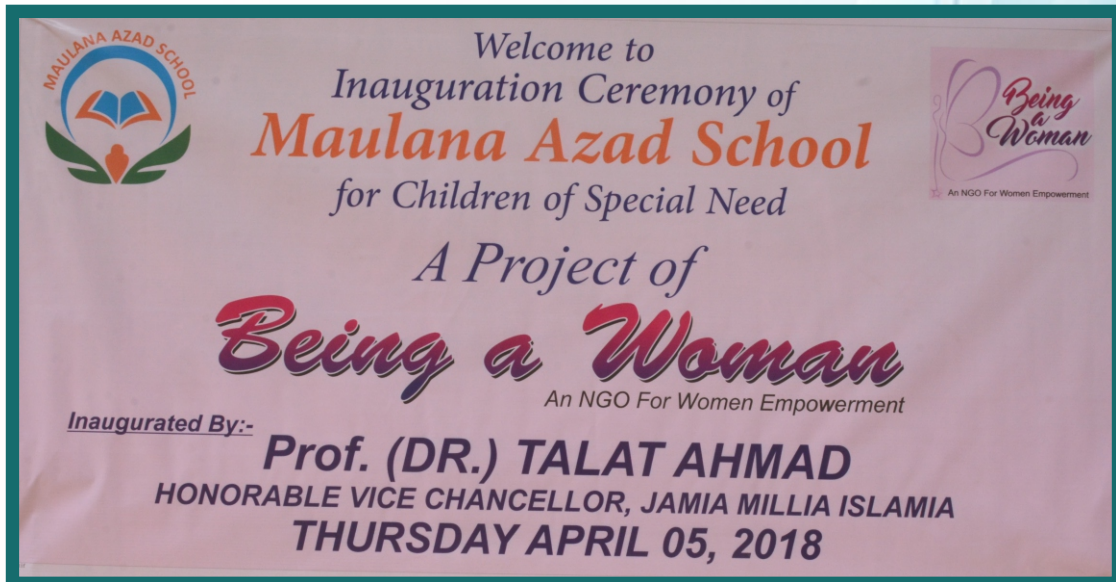

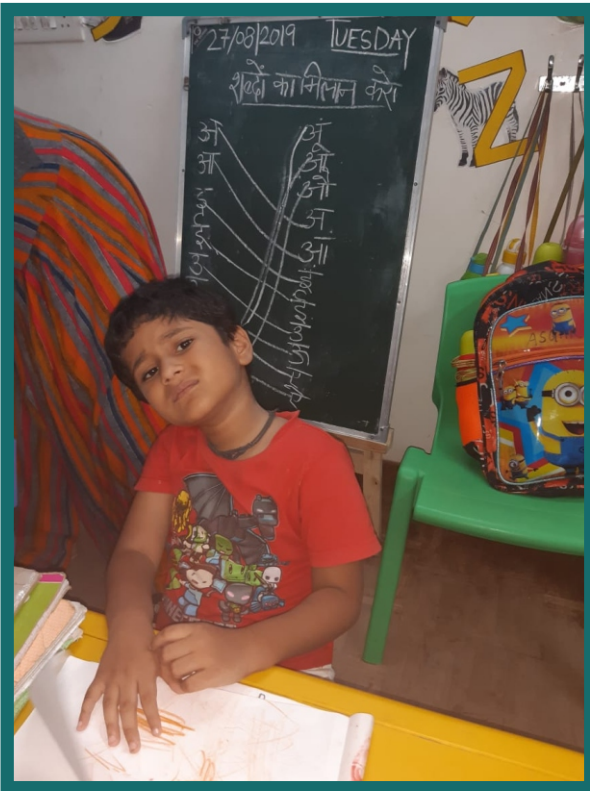


MAULANA AZAD SCHOOL

(For Children With Special Needs)

The year 2018 will be the historic year for us as we could succeed in opening a school for children with special needs and socially excluded children with full support and co-operation of the well-wishers without whom this was not possible at all. Their names will ever be remembered and written with the history of existence of the Maulana Azad School. The school is running in a small rented premises at D-56, Abul Fazal Enclave -1 Jamia Nagar, New Delhi-110025 since its inception i. e the 5th April 2018. To start with only 10 Children, two qualified special educators were engaged and the school started. It is a great pleasure to mention here that the first batch of class Nursery already completed successfully its Session 2018-2019. Within a short period of one year the school got recognition in the locality for maintaining a high level of standard in all respect. This is why a fresh batch of around 30 children has been admitted in class Nursery for the session 2019-2020. This is due to the earnest labour and sincere efforts of our special educators. At present there are altogether 50 children studying in our Maulana Azad School with total teaching staff of six comprising of three special educators, one speech therapist and two assistant teachers. The school is still being run only by the meagre help of individual donors.

Independence Day and Republic Day are celebrated by the children along with all staff of the school with all enthusiasm. Several cultural activities are performed by the children of the school. On these occasions distinguished guests from the locality are also invited to the celebrations along with all parents to the school children. Teachers Day is also celebrated in the school with all preparations. Doctors on call from 'Alshifa Multispeciality Hospital, Abul Fazal Enclave-1, Jamia Nagar, New Delhi-110025 are visiting the school for regular periodical health checkup of the children. The physiotherapist from Viola Hospital, Abul Fazal Enclave -1, Jamia Nagar, New Delhi-110025 is also called for physiotherapy of the children when needed. Talented children are given prizes for their activities in any field along with academic results. We introduced a very small group of children in a session like a tutorial class instead of a crowded class room. This has given a good image to our school among other schools in the locality.

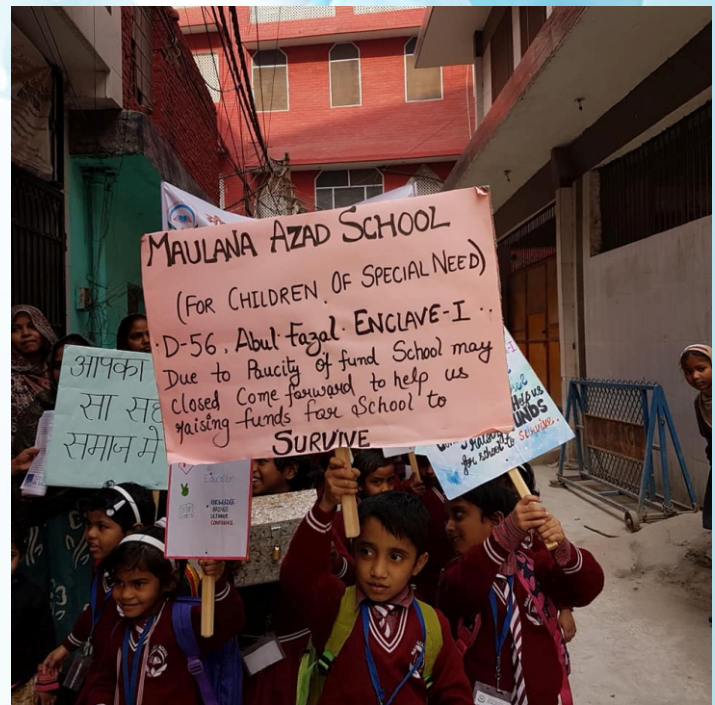

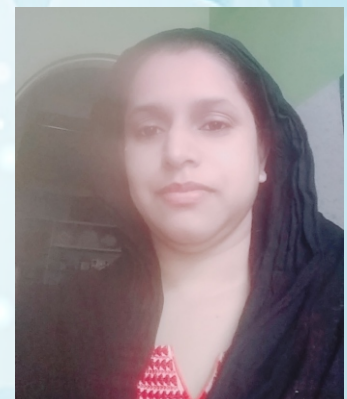
Achievement of the Maulana Azad School

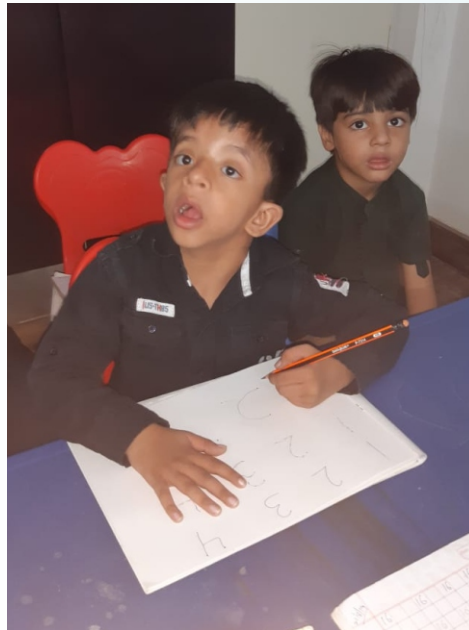
1. **Abdullah** – He was not able to utter any word. But now he can speak sentences. Earlier he was unable to hold the pencil but now he starts writing .He can identify different colors which he was not able to. Now he takes part in all activities of the school showing distinctive improvement .His mother is also very happy as she starts her day putting her son to our school being carefree of him.



His mother Mrs. Rana Firdaus speaks as “I visited several places to find out a good school and finally found Maulana Azad School most suitable for my son.



2. Sheesh – Sheesh when took admission to our school was brought by her mother lifting in her arms as he was not able to stand on his feet but now he is able to walk very well and takes part in all indoor games besides studies in the School



3. Arhan – Arhan was extremely hyper when he was brought for admission to our school .He was completely restless not sitting at a place for a while and storm like anything creating trouble all the time. His mother got her admitted in several schools in the past but she was never satisfied with them but now she is very much satisfied with our school as her son is showing improvement everyday. She praised all staff of the school for taking care of all children with special Needs.



His mother, Mrs. Nargis Perween speaks as “I am very much satisfied with the school as the concerned special educator is taking much care of my son. As a result I feel there is a great improvement in my son.



4. Asghar – Asgar was also a case of hyper activity. He used to take medicines to lessen the effect of hyper activity. He was very much crazy for his mother calling for her every time but now he has shown a great response to the technique applied to him and all care by our special educators. His hyper activity has lessened to a great extent



5. Maseerah Akhtar – Maseerah Akhtar is a born down syndrome. She could never be admitted to any school for children with special needs. As all such schools are situated at a distant place to this locality. With the establishment of the Maulana Azad School she could take admission to the school. There is a great improvement in her activities and behavior too by spending just 1 year in our school. She also got promotion from class nursery session 2018-2019 to class LKG session 2019-2020. Now everyone is surprised how this girl has changed so much, unbelievable. This may be treated as a great achievement for our school.

The reasons behind these achievements are the hard labour and sincere efforts of our special educators along with all support from the administration of the school.



Children here are treated like a flower to blossom. They are showered with motherly love and affections they need every time by all members of the staff of the school.

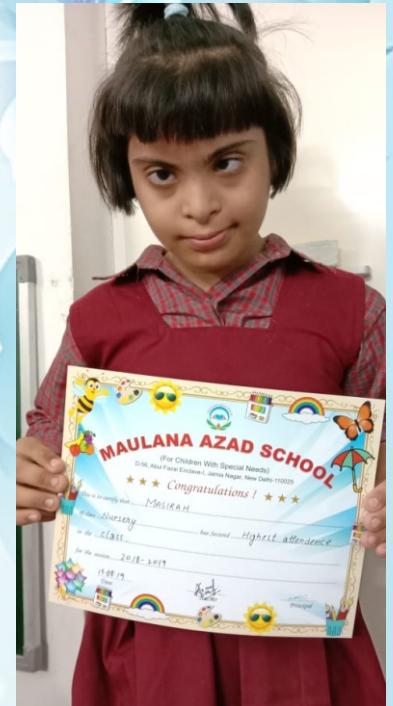

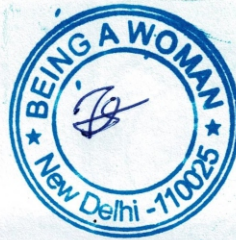
